

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
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


If you are a bird lover, whether an enthusiastic amateur or a seasoned pro, Guardamar and the surrounding area of the Southern Costa Blanca offers a wide variety of species uncommon elsewhere along with some more common ones. There is an abundance of birdlife that would impress any

European birder. Migratory periods in spring and autumn will, of course, bring in many water birds. Seawatchers have a plus at our river's pier, coastal dunes, beaches and neighbouring hills, where they can catch a glimpse of a bird list too long to mention in a short presentation.



Birders familiar with the Spanish Mediterranean coast may remember the names of bird havens such as El Fondo Reservoir in Elx-Crevillent, the Santa Pola Salt Pans, the Mouth of the River Segura in Guardamar or the Salt Lake Lagoons of la Mata and Torrevieja, all within a 15 minute drive from your accommodation in Guardamar.



Guardamar is a small district of 22 square miles and 17,000 inhabitants in the low seasons and is right in the middle of it all. It is a Mediterranean resort, 30 minutes south of Alicante International Airport with a large 2,500-acre coastal dune-pine forest abutting a 6-mile long beach of white sand to the north and south of the River Segura, which is 202 miles long from its source in southern Spain. Almost 80% of the district is made up of protected woodlands, sand dunes and traditional irrigation and dry farming lands.

Historically an area of fishing and farming-activities still pretty much alive-Guardamar translates as "Sea Lookout". Archaeologists have found long tunnel nests of European bee-eaters (Merops apiasters) on the sandy bank walls of La Fonteta; an 8th century BC Phoenician colony next to the River Segura's mouth. On that same site, green colour drawings of birds under a palm tree have been found on a lime plaster wall of the 10th century AD Ribat or Islamic retreat monastery, hidden under the sands for a thousand years. These pictograms include blue herons (Ardeo purpurea), mallards (Anas platyrhynchos) and other small birds.


